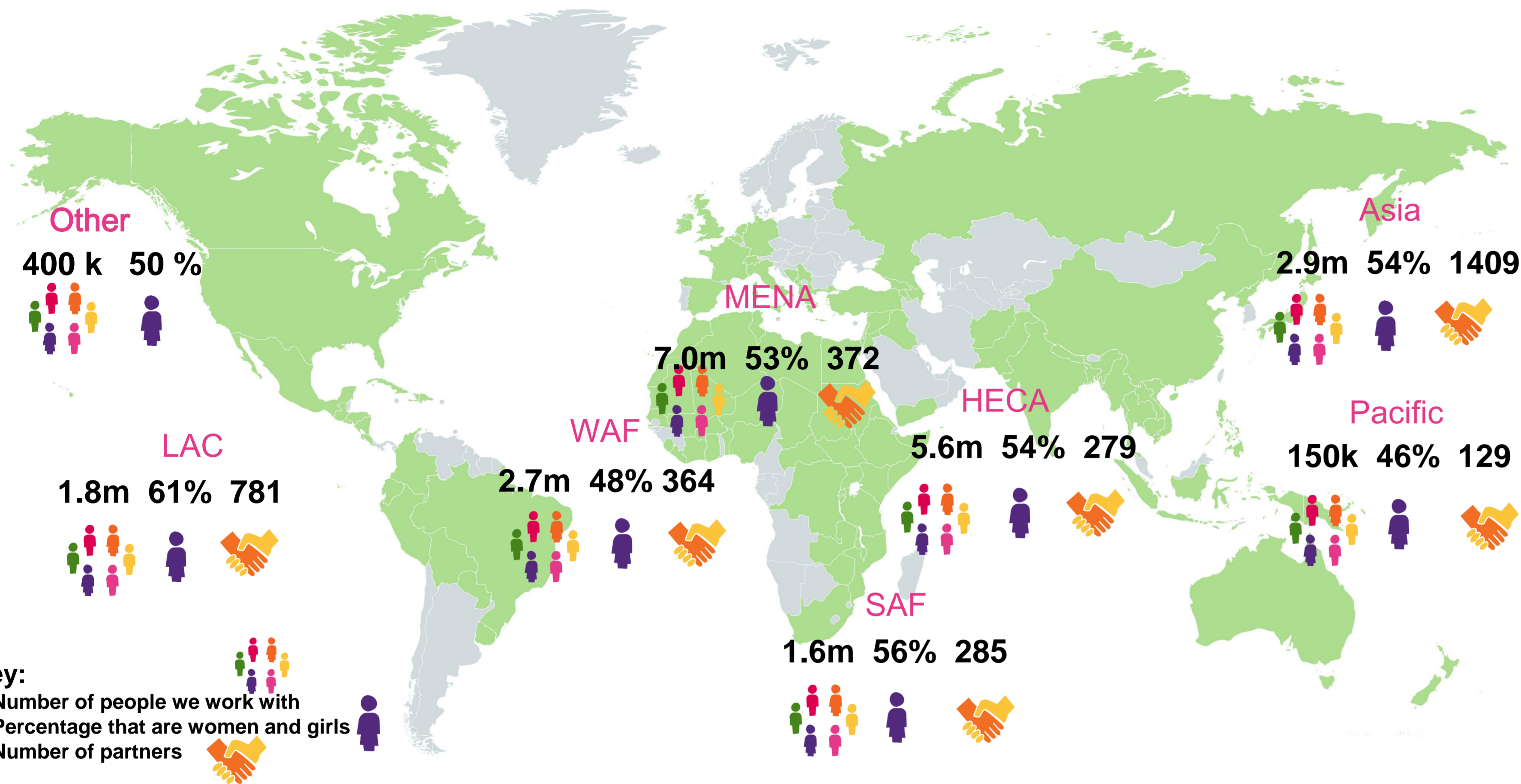


Our Reach and Scale 2017/18

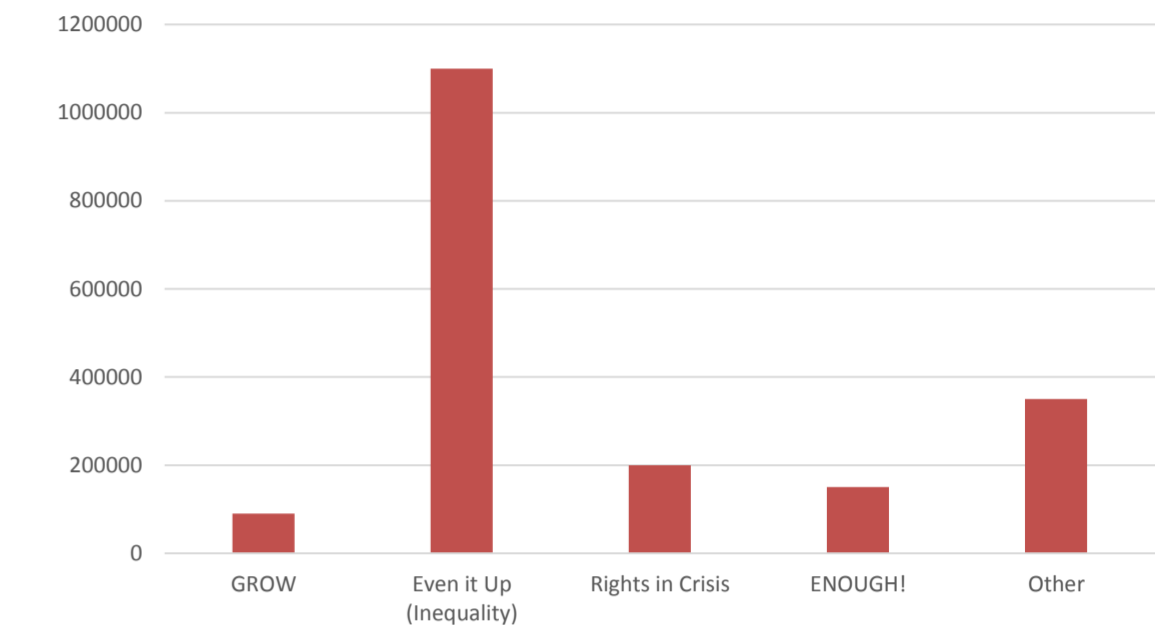
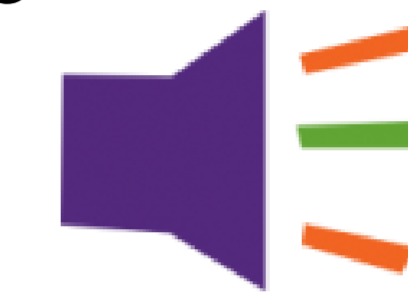
We worked directly with **22.3 Million** people in our programs worldwide; **53% are women and girls, 47% are men and boys***



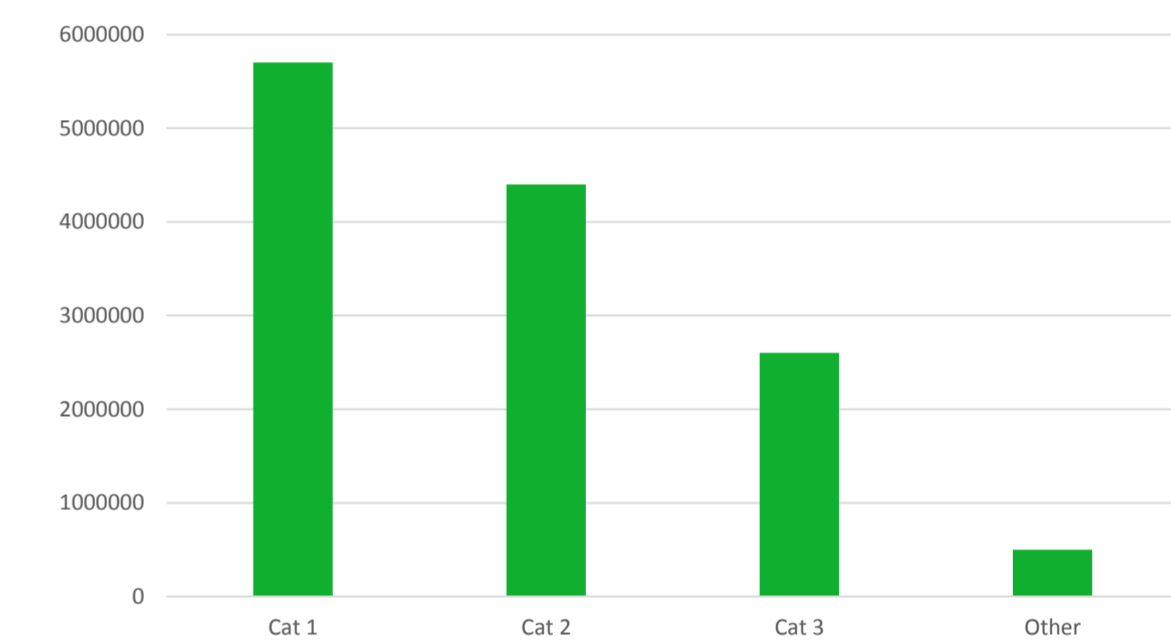
About the One Oxfam Output Reporting

People we work with are all project participants that are engaged in project activities and have direct access (benefit) to the products / services of the project. Activists are engaged individuals that take concrete actions to support an issue directly related to a particular campaign on behalf of others and do not benefit themselves from their action. The **Influencing** category is new for this year, so we are cautious of the quality of the data and will endeavor to improve it next year.

We mobilized **1.8 million** people to take action on behalf of others



Humanitarian assistance accounts for **59%** of the people we work with



We worked together with **3,663** unique partner organizations in both funding (64%) and non-funding (36%) relationships to achieve shared long-term goals.



Right to be heard

We worked with **1.5m** people and **1388** partner organizations in **384** projects. **47%** of these people are women and girls.

Gender Justice

We worked with **750K** people and **644** partner organizations in **235** projects. **66%** of these people are women and girls.

Saving lives

We worked with **17.3m** people (75% of them in humanitarian assistance) in **837** partner organizations in **487** projects. **54%** of these people are women and girls.

Sustainable food

We worked with **1.7m** people and **829** partner organizations in **358** projects. **54%** of these people are women and girls.

Natural Resources

We worked with **500k** people and **290** partner organizations in **112** projects. **44%** of these people are women and girls.

Financing Development

We worked with **700k** people and **562** partner organizations in **270** projects. **52%** of these people are women and girls.

Resilience

We worked with **1315** partner organizations in **697** of our projects which have a resilience component. **54%** of these people are women and girls.

VAWG/GBV

We worked with **929** partner organizations in **402** of our projects which have a VAW/GBV component. **53%** of these people are women and girls.
